

PARK HOMES

Park homes are detached single-storey homes that are smaller than a typical bungalow. They must be moveable in either one or two pieces and are manufactured off-site and moved to a site by vehicle.

Park homes are well-designed and look like a traditionally built bungalow with a pitched roof, just with a smaller footprint. The only real difference is in their construction, which is timber-framed with a weatherproof exterior and built on a steel frame base.



In 2019, it was estimated that there were approximately 85,000 households living in park homes on 2,000 sites across England alone.¹
